## AHF16

- Fast growing semi-dormant alfalfa variety
- Bushy type of growth habit with quicker regrowth after cutting than dormant alfalfas
- Excellent spring frost tolerance
- Demonstrated to be productive in saline soils
- Expresses very high forage yield capabilities in both a dormant and semi-dormant environment
- Exceptional forage quality - among the best
